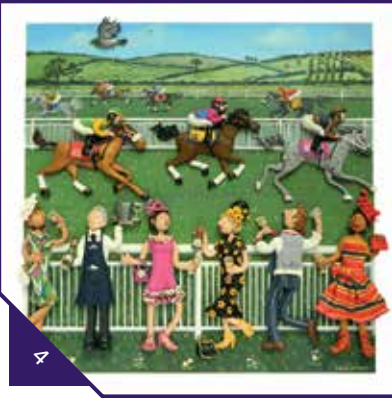


SILVER MOON GLASS

ERICA STURLA ORIGINAL ART

Erica works in polymer clay and acrylics to create lively and colourful three-dimensional scenes. ELLUL CERAMICS

Lisa's vessels are constructed from layers of finely rolled tubes or cones of clay. These are organised in a structured formation building the thickness of the vessel wall. Some vessels are multi-layered and hold a solid, weighted volume. Others are simple one-layer vessels resembling seed pods and cones. This method of construction creates an intricate texture and articulation of surface. Surfaces are almost bone like with fossilised leaf patterns or inlaid textures.

RUTH MAKES JEWELLERY

Ruth Sutcliffe and Jez Coates both create sterling silver jewellery capturing the moods and wildlife of their local West Yorkshire Pennine landscape. The antics of their pets, runes and textures also appear in their unique handmade designs, either hand sawn from sterling silver sheet or individually hand cast from recycled silver, often with brass or copper elements, oxidised or etched, and hallmarked at Birmingham Assay Office when required.

Sarah uses an amalgamation of transparent and opalescent sheet glass, handmade rolled glass, frits and powdered glass. She looks for chemical reactions between certain colours which gives an unpredictability to the outcome. She builds the artworks in layers which then have several firings. This is followed by cold-working to remove the 'shiny' aspect of glass. This reveals an extra depth to detail and colour, leaving a weathered texture.

Frankie Amos is a mosaic artist who designs and creates a variety of colourful and unique art pieces to brighten any home. She specialises in mirrors and wall art, including items such as clocks, wall hooks and coasters. She uses a mixed-media of hand-painted recycled glass, ceramic tiles, and glass tiles. Each piece is individually cut and shaped, and incorporates glitter and foil to create shimmering, iridescent colours which reflect and change in the light.

ANGELA HENDERSON - GLASS ARTIST

As an artist builds up a landscape adding layers of paint, Angela Henderson cuts and layers pieces of coloured glass and powders which are then fired to melt and fuse together. This process is repeated several times until the desired effect is achieved; black paint and 23 carat gold is then added for the finer details before the final firing. The fluid nature of melting glass adds energy and an organic feel to the pieces.

ART OF TRANSPARENCY

Although much of her fused glass at first glance may look abstract the work is strongly influenced by northern coastlines and rural fells. 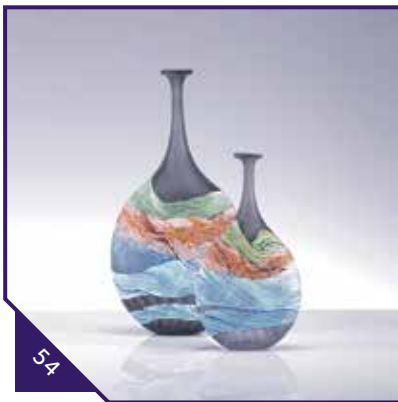


THRIFT DESIGN

Thomas Petit (Blown) Glass is made without moulds, making each piece completely individual. All colours are applied before blowing starts, by rolling molten glass into chips and powders. Many pieces are sandblasted to achieve a matt finish. Thomas's designs are often inspired by land/seascapes, with his design "Sea Shore", drawing from his experiences of walking over the South Downs and beaches in East Sussex.

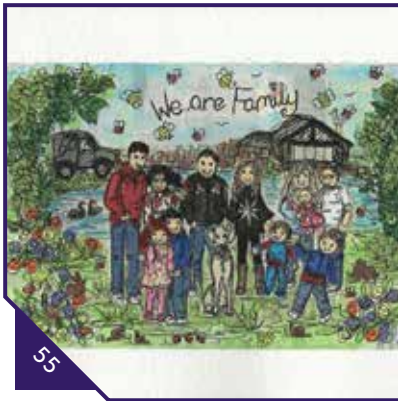


RUBY SPIRIT DESIGNS

Shaping and darting techniques are used to create a curved shape out of flat pieces of clay slabs, before modelling and trimming to enhance the shape and sharpen edges. Sometimes a layer of textured slip is added to a piece, and "dry" glazes and volcanic glazes are used to further create interesting details in the surface.
